We are asking for your help. More than a year ago the Second Lebanon War erupted. Of the 768 soldiers wounded in that War, many of them have been unable to resume life as it was for them and their families before the war. Two of the soldiers remain in a coma, many have lost limbs, many have their vision and/or hearing impaired, many have become wheelchair-bound. There are also many soldiers whose injuries lie in the realm of the unseen -- suffering from nightmares, depression, anxiety.

Our soldiers fought valiantly and we are proud...very proud of them. Unfortunately, most of the world wants to portray them not as heroes, but as ruthless attackers. There is a deep conviction in my heart, that the Israeli army is one of the most moral armies in the world.

We at Light and Mercy want to give honor to those who fought and were wounded in the Second Lebanon War. We are planning an event to honor them this coming February, which is detailed in the attachment. We want them to know that what they have done is remembered, and the sacrifices they made have touched us all.

There is not much time left to raise the funds needed for this project. We assure you that this event is not frivolous in any way. We feel it is a holy work that will help to heal the pain in these wounded soldiers' hearts, allowing them to feel whole again.

Please, we have an urgent need to reach others who will see the importance of this project and help us raise the funds needed. No matter how small a contribution you may be able to make, it will be appreciated far beyond what is expressed in this letter.
